 - Minimum average annual construction turnover of NRP 137 million or US\$ 1.20 million or equivalent calculated as total certified payments of the best 3 (three) years received for contracts in progress or completed within the last 5 (five) years;
 - ii) Successful completion as main supplier within the last 3 (Three) years, of at least 2(Two) contracts each valued at NPR 50 million or equivalent to USD 0.43 Million with nature, and complexity similar to the scope of supply described in Section 6 (Schedule of Supply).
 - iii) The Bidder shall demonstrate that the goods offered have a) been in production for at least 5 (Five) years; b) been sold a minimum of 3 (three) units of similar type and specification over the last three (3) years; and c) been in operation for a minimum of 3 (three) years.
